

QSE Advanced Student's DVD-ROM

The *QSE Advanced Student's DVD-ROM* contains all 20 audio and video clips to go with Exercise 4 (**Watch and Listen**, or **Listen**) for each Unit of the Student's Book. There are also PDF files of the transcripts of the audio and video clips that can be printed out.

The DVD-ROM can be played on a DVD player or a personal computer with a DVD player. From the main menu students can access all the different parts of the DVD-ROM. To return to the main menu at any time, students click on the **BACK** button in the bottom right-hand corner of the screen.

Units 1-20 Audio and Video Clips

The audio and video clips are each approximately three to four minutes long. There are six video clips and 14 audio clips. Units 2, 6, 12 and 19 have a pause in the clip linked to an activity in which the student is asked to speculate on what will come next or what people may be thinking about a situation. Just before the pause, the words *PAUSE coming up* appear on the screen. After the pause, the clip continues. To hold the pause for longer, press the pause button on the DVD. To continue, press the play button on the DVD.
